Please think about men: Techie kills self, blames wife in video

An IT firm employee, Ma in Agra died by suicide after reportedly live-streaming on social media. An FIR registered at Sadar Bazaar Police Station, based on the deceased's father's complaint, mentioned strained relations between the man and his wife.

The deceased before taking his own life made a live video. In the video, the man blamed his wife for his suicide.

DCP Agra Suraj Rai said, "On February 27, 2025, through social media, a video came to our knowledge wherein a man was speaking live before dying by suicide. Taking cognisance of

the video, a case was registered under relevant sections in connection with a complaint...All facts and allegations will be investigated and action will be taken based on evidence." The victim Manav Sharma, a resident of Defence Colony in Sadar area, was working as a recruitment manager in an IT firm. The deceased's father filed a complaint in Sadar police station in Agra.

The FIR stated, "The applicant Narendra Kumar Sharma is resident of Defence Colony, Police Station Sadar Bazar, Agra. The applicant's son Manav Sharma married a resident Agra, according to Hindu customs without dowry on January 1, 2024. Since the mar-



riage, daughter-in-law Niketa did not behave well with the applicant's son and other family members. She used to get furious over small things and start fighting in the house." The FIR further stated that Manav Sharma used to work in

Mumbai, so he took his wife with him to Mumbai, where the wife used to allegedly fight with him every day and allegedly used to openly threaten the applicant's son that she would die by suicide and get him trapped in a case.

"The applicant's son, being harassed and troubled, spoke about the activities of the daughter-in-law several times on the phone, then the applicant explained to him that the marriage has just taken place and everything would be fine," the FIR further said.

The applicant said that there was no improvement in the behavior of daughter-in-law and she allegedly kept harassing his son mentally while living with

him, due to which the applicant's son became a victim of depression.

"The applicant's son came to Agra from Mumbai with his wife on February 23, 2025 and on the same date went to his wife's maternal home in Agra, where her family members humiliated him and instigated him to die by suicide. The applicant's son returned home feeling harassed. Manav died by suicide by hanging himself on February 24," the FIR added.

The applicant immediately informed the police and then took his son to Military Hospital, Agra for treatment where the doctors declared him dead.

Cong to Kerala unit: Toe party line or face action

Close on the heels of the row over its MP Shashi Tharoor's recent remarks, the Congress top brass on Friday issued a stern warning to its Kerala leaders, asserting that strong action will be taken against those making comments that go against party interests.

At a meeting to deliberate the Congress' strategy in Kerala, former party chief Rahul Gandhi said leaders should be very careful about the political strategy and should not do or say anything which does not toe the party line, according to sources.

The nearly three-hour meeting at the Congress' Indira Bhawan headquarters here had discipline, unity and strengthening of the state organisation as its running theme. Congress president Mallikarjun Kharge stressed on discipline, ensuring unity and on filling up the vacant posts to strengthen the Kerala Congress organisation.

Besides Kharge and Rahul Gandhi, AICC general secretary K C Venugopal, Wayanad MP Priyanka Gandhi Vadra, Kerala Congress chief K Sudhakaran were present in the meeting.

VISA FRAUD CASE

US Embassy files complaint over fake documents

The US Embassy in the national capital lodged a complaint with the Delhi Police regarding submission of fake educational and financial documents to procure a US visa, an official said on Friday.

A case was registered at the Chanakypuri Police Station on January 2 by the Office of the Overseas Criminal Investigations in the US Embassy.

The accused have been identified as Mandeep Singh and Jarnail Singh, read the FIR.

According to the FIR, Mandeep applied for a nonimmigrant visa at the US Embassy in New Delhi and submitted a Bachelor of Science degree certificate issued by a technical university in Punjab's Jalandhar and also presented a bank balance confirmation certificate issued by a bank with a balance amount of Rs 39 lakh along with a bank statement.

"However, during the interview with the US Embassy officials on January 2, Mandeep admitted that he did

not earn a B.Sc degree from the university. Further, he stated that the bank balance confirmation certificate and bank statements were fraudulent," it read.

Mandeep stated that the fraudulent degree and bank documents were provided by Jarnail, who is the owner of an English teaching academy located in Amritsar.

He stated that he paid Rs 2 lakh to Jarnail for the fraudulent documents and his assistance with processing his visa, read the FIR.

The US Embassy alleged that the accused conspired to cheat the US Embassy in India and the US government to obtain a visa based on such forged and fraudulent claims and misrepresentations.

"The US Embassy requests support from the Delhi Police and the Government of India to conduct this investigation in the most expeditious manner possible, as cases involving the attempt to procure US travel documents by fraudulent means is a serious security matter that affects both the United States and India," the FIR stated.

Speaking in the Assembly during a discussion on the motion of thanks on the lieutenant governor's inaugural address in



the House, Gupta took a dig at the AAP, calling it a "dharna party" for staging protests over the alleged removal of B R Ambekar and Bhagat Singh's portraits from the CM office.

"Atishi and other AAP MLAs

were holding up banners even before we took the oath, asking when will we give Rs 2,500 each to women. They dare to question us when they themselves failed to fulfil the same promise in Punjab. They are a dharna party -- when in power, they sat on protests, now they are in the opposition and they are still doing the same," the chief minister said.

She also hit out at the AAP for staging protests over the alleged removal of B R Ambekar's and Bhagat Singh's portraits from the CM office.

Make Punjab drug-free in three months: CM Mann to CPs, DCs

The SpaDeX mission was launched on December 30 last year when it placed in orbit two satellites - SDX01 and SDX02 - to demonstrate the docking experiment in space.

UAPA added to defeat our order: SC raps Chh'garh cops

The Supreme Court on Friday came down heavily on Chhattisgarh Police for booking a man under the Unlawful Activities Prevention Act (UAPA) days after it gave him interim protection from arrest in a murder case.

A bench of Justices Abhay S Oka and Ujjal Bhuyan said the UAPA charge was added by the police with an intent to defeat its January 2 interim bail order and granted him bail.

"Considering fact that it is so apparent that appellant was arrested only to defeat January 2 order, appellant is entitled to be bail in said case. Appeal allowed. The appellant shall be enlarged on bail," the bench said.

The bench went on, "This hasty action has been taken by the police against the appellant to ensure that he is taken into custody and interim order dated January 2 is nullified." Terming it as "gross impropriety", the bench deprecated the conduct of the police official and warned him of contempt for an overreach of the court order.

"This is gross impropriety committed by the police officer. We will not hesitate to initiate action for criminal contempt of court," court said.
