# Rahul faces ‘Opposition’ over dead economy jibe

Leader of Opposition in Lok Sabha Rahul Gandhi on Thursday endorsed US President Donald Trump's remarks counting India along with Russia among the "dead economies" while some other Opposition leaders differed with the opinion.

In a social media post, Trump had written, "I don't care what India does with Russia. They can take their dead economies down together, for all I care."

Asked about the remarks in the Parliament complex, Gandhi said, "He is right, everybody knows this except the Prime Minister and the Finance Minister. I am glad that President Trump has stated a fact."

Gandhi later also posted on "X" that "THE INDIAN ECONOMY IS DEAD. Modi killed it. 1. Adani-Modi partnership 2. Demonetisation and a flawed GST 3. Failed "Assemble in India" 4. MSMEs wiped out 5. Farmers crushed by Modi have destroyed the future of India's youth because there are no jobs."

His views were shared by



party general secretary Ran-deep Surjewala, who elaborated on the issue saying, "The imposition of a 25 per cent tariff on India, along with penalties, will be catastrophic for our economy". He also took a swipe at the PM saying, "Events like 'Namaste Trump,' 'Howdy Modi,' and 'Abki Baar Trump Sarkar' show that Modinomics and Modi diplomacy have failed. Our advice to the Modi government is that national interest should be paramount."

Party MP Shashi Tharoor, whose growing ties with Modi and the ruling dispensation have often given rise to specu-

## BJP ATTACKS LOP

The BJP played Gandhi for "echoing" US President Donald Trump's "dead economy" jibe at India, calling it a "shameful" insult to the aspirations, achievements and well-being of the people of the country as it asked the Congress leader why he "repeats" foreign propaganda that undermines the country. BJP IT department head Amit Malviya said in a post on X: "Rahul Gandhi has hit a new low by echoing 'dead economy' jibe -- a shameful insult to the aspirations, achievements, and well-being of the Indian people." "But let's be honest -- the only thing truly 'dead' here is Rahul Gandhi's own political credibility and legacy," he added.

Citing data showing growth in various sectors, the BJP leader said, "This is not a dead economy. This is a surging, resilient India."

In a post on "X", Chaturvedi wrote: "Not that one needs to say it, there's enough legitimate data available to know that the Indian economy is in the Top 5 of the world and one of the fastest growing economies. Calling it a dead economy can only come from a position of arrogance or ignorance. Thank you for your attention to this matter!"

## Gogoi Pak links: NIA probe likely after Sep 10

Assam Chief Minister Himanta Biswa Sarma on Thursday said that the probe related to Pakistan links of Congress MP Gaurav Gogoi and his wife Elizabeth Coleburn might be handed over to National Investigation Agency (NIA) following the final report submission by the Special Investigation Team (SIT).

The Chief Minister addressed the ongoing investigation into allegations involving Gogoi and his wife's purported links to Pakistan, acknowledging limitations in the current probe being carried out by the state's Special Investigation Team (SIT).

Speaking at a press conference, CM Sarma pointed out that the Assam SIT has a restricted mandate, particularly in accessing

communication records. "The SIT in Assam has a very limited scope. It cannot access telephonic records or connections beyond two years," he said.

Despite these constraints, the CM commended the SIT for working diligently within its remit.

The Chief Minister underlined that the case's broader dimensions -- concerning citizenship and alleged connections with the Organisation of Islamic Cooperation (OIC) -- fall within the jurisdiction of the Union Ministry of Home Affairs.

The central probe agencies such as the National Investigation Agency (NIA), he noted, have the capacity to retrieve information dating back to 2010-2011. Sarma clarified that the state government has not yet requested the NIA to take over the investigation.

## Ex-TN CM OPS snaps ties with NDA

Former Tamil Nadu Chief Minister O Panneerselvam-led AIADMK Cadres Rights Retrieval Committee on Thursday walked out of the BJP-led NDA coalition.

Panruti S Ramachandran, a veteran leader and advisor to the Committee announced the decision.

Speaking to reporters, Ramachandran, flanked by Panneerselvam and panel leaders said: "Hereafter, the Committee will not be a part of the National Democratic Alliance (NDA)." The decision to move away from the NDA was unanimous, he said answering a question.

On behalf of the Committee, its chief, Panneerselvam will soon commence tour of several parts of the state and it has been resolved to decide on the question of alliance in future according to the political circumstances, he added.

Asked on the reasons for quitting the NDA, Ramachan-



dran said the reason was widely known and there was no necessity to explain it.

He expressing confidence that "a right alliance to lead the people in the right direction will materialise in future." Asked if the BJP has betrayed Panneerselvam-led panel, Ramachandran said he need not spell out what the BJP did to the Committee as the nation knows it.

To a question, Panneerselvam said he met Stalin here during his morning walk and that he moved on after conveying his pleasantries.

Shah has assured to take steps to release arrested nuns: UDF MP

UDF MP, N K Premachandran, told reporters in New Delhi after a delegation of MPs from Kerala met Shah over the issue, that the minister has assured them of all legal steps by the Centre and the Chhattisgarh government to ensure the release of the two nuns.

## AIIMS Patna guard's kids burned alive at home

With Bihar assembly election a few months away, the law and order situation in the state seems to be spiralling out of control as charred bodies of two minor siblings were found in a room at Nagwa village under Janipur police station limits in the state capital on Thursday as the family alleged that someone first killed children and then set their bodies on fire.

Phulwari Sharif DSP 2, Deepak Kumar said that police were investigating the matter from all angles.

Meanwhile, people agitated over the incident blocked roads and burnt tyres to vent out their ire. The deceased had been identified as Anjali Kumari (15) and Anshul Kumar (10). A team

of FSL reached the spot and launched a thorough investigation into the incident. The deceased children's father Lallan Gupta works in the local Election Commission office while the mother works in AIIMS, Patna. While talking to reporters, he asserted that criminals might have been following their children after classes in their school were over, asking how such a heinous crime could happen in just one and half hours. He claimed that two to three men were seen near the house. He also alleged that perpetrators first killed them and later set them on fire.

If it was an accident, the boys would have run for their lives and could have even opened the door, but there was no such effort from their side, which proves that someone first killed

them and then burnt their bodies, he added.

The mother of deceased children informed her husband about the tragedy after she returned from her duty.

Relatives of the victims cried inconsolably with hundreds of villagers gathered at the spot as police searched throughout the entire area to collect evidence.

"I want to burn them (culprits) alive. Police should catch them today itself," Gupta commented as a pall of gloom descended on the village with people clueless what was happening in the state at regular intervals.

"Had it been someone from the chief minister's or some higher official's family, police would have been prompt in the investigation and quick to arrest culprits," Gupta said.

## DIDI HIKES AID FOR DURGA PUJA COMMITTEES IN MAJOR HINDUTVA PUSH

In a major pre-poll announcement, West Bengal Chief Minister Mamata Banerjee has increased the state government's financial grant for 40,000 Durga Puja committees to Rs 1.10 lakh, up from last year's Rs 85,000. She also declared an 80% rebate on electricity bills for these committees. The announcement was made at the Netaji Indoor Stadium in Kolkata and comes ahead of the

2026 Assembly elections.

This is also being looked at as a major Hindutva push to "out-smart" the Saffron force.

"We want the committees to manage expenses without stress. We are for the people and moreover Durga Puja is not just a religious celebration, it is a cultural festival that unites everyone. This year, no fees will be charged by civic bodies, fire brigade or state-run service providers. CESC will provide power at 80 per cent concession. Last year, this was 75 per cent. I have

already spoken with them," said Mamata. Notably, in 2018 she had given a grant of Rs 10000 which rose to Rs 25000 in 2019. During Covid 19 pandemic the grant rose to Rs 50000. In 2024, it was pegged at Rs 85000.

### POLITICAL REACTIONS & OPPOSITION CRITICISM

Opposition parties, especially the BJP, have criticised it as a politically motivated step to bolster the ruling Trinamool Congress's Hindu support base. The BJP has often accused Banerjee of indulging in minority

appeasement, and now claims that she is trying to win back ground ahead of the 2026 elections.

Leader of Opposition Suwendu Adhikari argued that the state should prioritise providing jobs and inflation allowance (DA) before increasing festival grants. In her defence, Banerjee hit back at critics: "Some drag matters to court, some say I don't allow Durga Puja, others ask why I support it. This is our festival -- why shouldn't we support it?"
