

US revokes visa of 91-year-old Wole Soyinka

Nigerian Nobel laureate Wole Soyinka, who had regular teaching stints in America's Ivy League Universities, has said the United States revoked his visa and banned him from entering the country.

The 91-year-old author, who became the first African to win the Nobel Prize in Literature in 1986, revealed that the US consulate had asked him to bring in his passport so his visa could be cancelled in person, citing new unspecified information that had come to light.

"I have no visa. I am banned," he declared on Tuesday. When asked if he would consider returning to the US, Soyinka simply replied, "How old am I?"

Soyinka, who has been a vocal critic of the Trump administration's hardline immigration stance, suggested that his outspoken comments may have led to the revocation. He referenced his recent comparison of Donald Trump to Uganda's late dictator, saying, "When I called Donald Trump Idi Amin, I thought I was paying him a compliment," adding that Trump "has been behaving like a dictator." Idi Amin, who ruled Uganda from 1971 to 1979, was notorious for his brutal regime and widespread human rights abuses.

Soyinka described the request as a "rather curious love letter from an embassy" during a news conference held on Tuesday.

PIO shot dead outside house in Canada

A 68-year-old Indian-origin businessman was shot dead outside his house in Canada's British Columbia province in a suspected "targeted incident", according to media reports and police. Darshan Sahsi was killed on Monday in the province's Abbotsford city. Police responded to a report of a shooting on Ridgeview Drive, where they found Sahsi inside a vehicle, suffering from life-threatening injuries, Abbotsford Police said in a statement on Monday. He succumbed to his injuries despite the lifesaving medical efforts of first responders. While the statement did not identify Sahsi, the Integrated Homicide Investigation Team (IHIT) later named him as the victim.

Rape charge in assault on PIO woman

A man arrested on suspicion of the racially aggravated sexual assault of an Indian-origin woman in Walsall has been charged with rape and appeared before Birmingham Magistrates Court on Wednesday. The West Midlands Police said John Ashby, "who is a white British man aged 32 from Stockland Green", was charged on Tuesday evening. The rape charge comes after a woman in her 20s, identified locally as a Sikh student, was attacked in the Park Hall area of Walsall on Saturday night. "He was also charged with sexual assault, strangulation, racially aggravated actual bodily harm and robbery," the police said. She is supported by our specially-trained officers, they said.

US & South Korea seal broad trade agreement

The United States and South Korea have reached a broad agreement on a new trade deal, officials from both nations confirmed following talks between their leaders on Wednesday.

The deal, largely negotiated during a nearly two-hour meeting between US President Donald Trump and South Korean President Lee Jae Myung, includes an immediate reduction of taxes on vehicle and car parts.

South Korean presidential aide Kim Yong-beom confirmed that while reciprocal tariffs will be maintained at the previously negotiated 15%, tariffs on the auto sector will be lowered. President Trump, who is on a week-long Asia trip, described the deal as "pretty much finalized," adding that "a lot was determined" during the "tremendous meeting."

Investment and Context

The trade agreement is bolstered by a massive South Korean investment package in the US. Kim Yong-beom stated that South Korea will invest \$350 billion in the US, which includes a \$200 billion cash investment along with \$150 billion in shipbuilding.

Democrats force Senate vote to block Trump's tariffs on Brazil

Washington: The Senate was voting on Tuesday evening on legislation that would nullify President Donald Trump's tariffs on Brazil, including oil, coffee and orange juice, as Democrats tested GOP senators' support. The legislation from Virginia Sen. Tim Kaine, a Democrat, would terminate the national emergencies that Trump has declared to justify the tariffs. He's planning to call up similar resolutions applying to Trump's tariffs on Canada and other nations later this week.

The legislation is likely doomed because the Republican-controlled House has passed new rules that allow leadership to prevent it from ever coming up for a vote.

comes as a relief to South Korea's auto, electronics, and chip industries, which had been seeking clarity amidst recent tariff chaos.

Tensions between the historically strong allies had recently spiked following an immigration raid in the US that detained hundreds of South Korean nationals.
