# BLAZE | Kochi & Kozhikode hosps on alert for medical attention of the crew SG cargo ship catches fire

A major fire broke out on board a Singapore-flagged ship after a container explosion off the Kerala coast on Monday, defence sources said. Eighteen crew members were rescued, while four remain missing.

The incident occurred at approximately 9.20 am IST, around 44 nautical miles off Azhikkal in Kannur district of Kerala and 130 nautical miles northwest of Kochi.

Defence sources said that of the 22 crew members on board the Singapore-flagged container ship, MV Wan Hai 503, 18 who had abandoned the vessel were rescued by Indian Navy and Coast Guard assets.

They are being brought to Mangaluru Port on the Navy ship INS Surat for dis-


embarkation and further necessary procedures.

The vessel was enroute from Colombo, Sri Lanka to Nhava Sheva, Mumbai, with an expected time of arrival (ETA) on June 10, 2025.

"The fire rapidly engulfed the mid-section of the vessel, which is currently adrift. Preliminary reports suggest that 10-15 containers have fallen overboard," a Coast Guard release said.

The crew members include eight Chinese, six Taiwanese, five Myanmarese, and three Indonesian nationalities.

"Following the explosion and escalation of the fire, the crew abandoned the ship. 18 crew members have been rescued, while four remain missing. A search and rescue operation is currently underway," the release said.



The containers in the ship have dangerous cargo, including Class 3 (flammable liquids), Class 4.1 (flammable solids), Class 4.2 (spontaneously combustible substances) and Class 4.6 (toxic substances)

## HIGHLIGHTS

- Of the 22 crew members on board the ship, MV Wan Hai 503, 18 have abandoned the vessel and are being rescued by Indian Navy and Coast Guard assets, a defence PRO said.
- The 270-metre-long vessel, with a draught of 12.5 metres, had departed Colombo on June 7 and was en route to Mumbai.
- Defence sources said the Indian Coast Guard ships Sachet, Arnav, Samudra Prahar, Abhinav, Rajdoot, and C-144 were involved in the on-going rescue operation.
- It was the second incident involving cargo vessels off the Kerala coast in a month. On 24 May, a Liberian-flagged cargo vessel, MSC ELSA-3, sank 14.6 nautical miles off the coast.

## Curfew, shutdown cripple normal life in Manipur

Normal life was badly affected in five valley districts of Manipur on Monday due to the indefinite curfew and 10-day shutdown, called by the Meitei radical outfit Arambai Tenggol.

To control the prevailing situation, the state government has banned mobile Internet and data services on Saturday midnight for five days and imposed an indefinite curfew in five Imphal valley districts -- Imphal West, Imphal East, Thoubal, Bish-

nupur, and Kakching.

Arambai Tenggol has called the 10-day shutdown in Manipur from Sunday to protest against the arrest of their leader by central security agencies.

Arambai Tenggol leader Ashram Kanan Singh (46) was arrested by the Central Bureau of Investigation (CBI) in Imphal for his criminal activities which include several acts of grave nature and involvement in unlawful activities and criminal cases registered against him, police statement said on Sunday.

He also appealed to the people of the state to maintain peace urging them to adopt democratic methods of protest.

"I want to appeal to everyone, including mothers and brothers, that this is a crucial time for the state. All should be careful in their actions and words," he said.

## Married woman fatally stabbed 17 times by lover in Bengaluru

Close on the heels of the tragic Raja Raghuvanshi murder case in Meghalaya that rocked the nation, a shocking incident came to light from Bengaluru on Monday, where a software professional fatally stabbed his married lover 17 times as she was unable to meet him often after her husband became suspicious.

The incident occurred recently in an OYO hotel room located in Poornaprajna Lay-

out, within the limits of the Subramanyapura police station, according to police.

The deceased has been identified as 36-year-old Harini, and the accused as Yashas, a techie.

### THE INCIDENT

According to the police, Harini was married with two children and was having an extramarital affair with the accused. Police investigations revealed that Yashas and Harini met at a fair, exchanged numbers, and began chatting. Their relationship progressed to dating and eventually involved physical intimacy.

Meanwhile, Harini's husband grew suspicious, confiscated her phone, and restricted her from leaving their residence.

After several months, Harini managed to leave her home and contacted Yashas. Police stated that Yashas, unable to cope with the separation from Harini, had become distraught and decided to kill her. On June 6, they met and went to the hotel.

Police reported that after getting intimate with her, the accused repeatedly stabbed her with a knife before escaping from the hotel.

In a post on X, Khera said there were several recent developments that lead to the belief that India's foreign policy has collapsed. He said this also includes funding to Pakistan from different world forums and organisations.

Congress's media and publicity department in-charge Pawan Khera said India's "muscular foreign policy" has failed to deliver and claimed that several recent developments allude to this. He said these include China's support for the territorial claims of Pakistan and Nepal; and Organi-

sia, all demanding a 'fair probe.' Incidentally, the Ministry of External Affairs has clarified that the ban on visas was linked to the ongoing Haj pilgrimage and that Saudi Arabia has temporarily banned various visas – including e-visas, family visit visas, and tourist visas.

The Saudi Government has not issued any notification on this matter. As a matter of practice, during the Haj season, temporary restrictions are imposed on short-term visas to prevent overcrowding, which will end with the conclusion of Hajj," it was quoted as saying.
